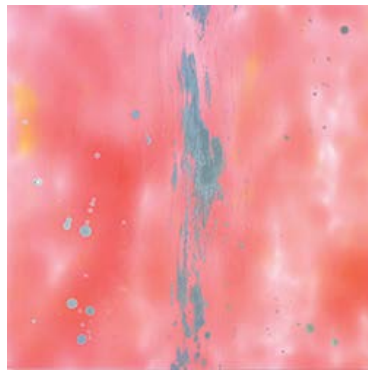


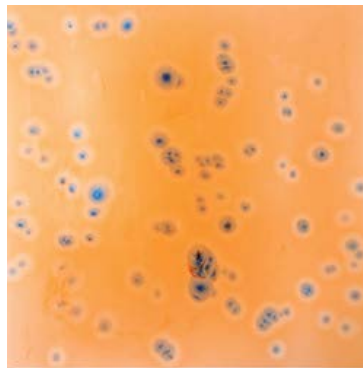
EXHIBITIONS Miik Green *Limbo* 7th October 2014 - 25th October 2014

'Limbo' is a continuation of Green's Xylem series, paintings that combine unlike materials that are sealed within layers of resin. Using mixed media on aluminium, Green creates translucent, high gloss & colourful surfaces that seemingly capture movement in the momentary. Pigments, inks and resins are mixed with resistant media as diverse as liquid zirconia and thorium, creating structures that react and emerge within the surfaces of the works.

It is this paradoxical space, set between two extremes in which the work evolves from: a site of conflict and tension where the cellular division of mitosis could also be seen as pathogenic replication.

In this process of intricate unconcealment, shapes take on an ambiguous clarity, appearing geographic and biological, dentritic and leguminous. The lustrous surfaces and colours that evolve both contain and encapsulate this tension and conflict, pausing movement in a limbo-like state. Here we see everything from the micro, the inner morphometry of the cellular, to the macro of cosmic array.

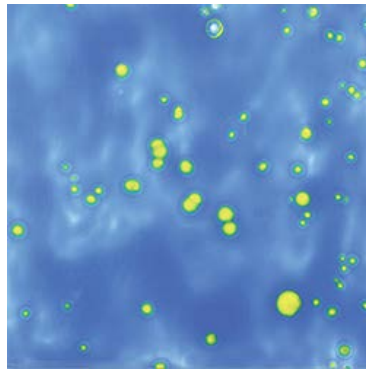


Green draws his inspiration from the microscopic aspects of nature, and is currently involved in cross-disciplinary artistic collaborations that integrate the fields of science, mathematics, chemistry and physics. He was shortlisted for the prestigious Aesthetica Art Award 2013 (York, UK), has also been invited to present at two conferences (Budapest 2013 - Arts + Society, Hawaii 2014 - Art + Humanities conference), and has been invited to speak at Symbiotica (prestigious artistic laboratory, UWA) as part of an ongoing collaboration with Chris Malajczuk, nanotechnologist. 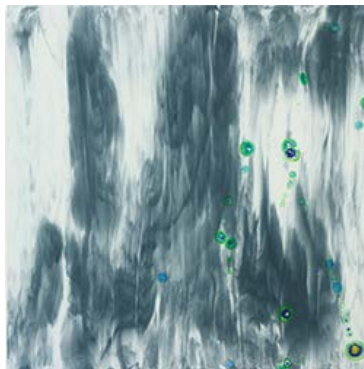

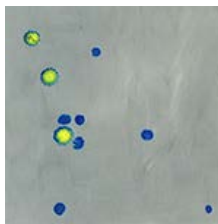

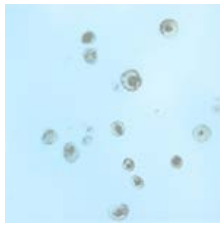

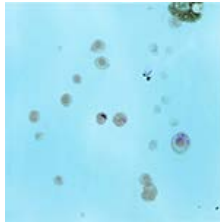

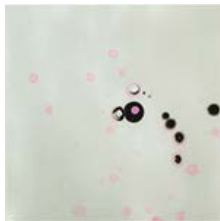

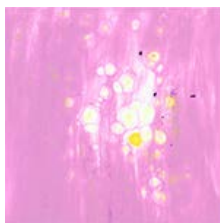

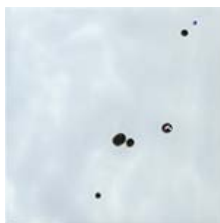
