



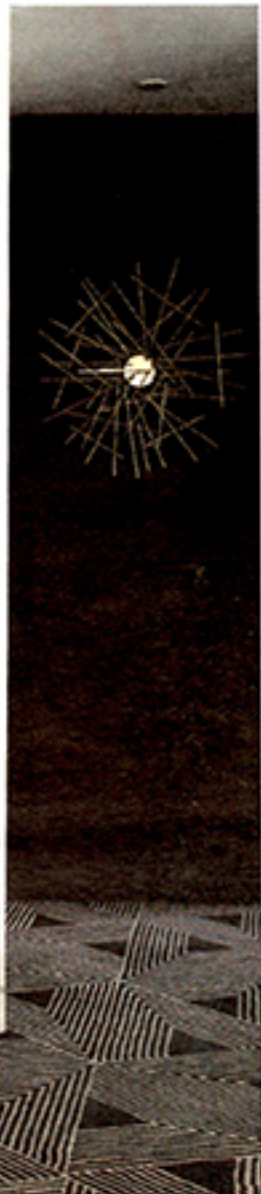
# BOLD MOVES
